Members fee 2023/2024

Past years economy

CIS income is based in part on the membership fees, grants from the government and sponsorships from different actors. Since CIS has had a stable economy throughout the past years and with a continuously high member count it seems reasonable to have a members fee of at least 150 SEK. On the other hand increasing the amount would be counteractive since a major part of CIS is to provide cheap and accessible activities for Chalmers students. During the financial year of 22/23 several sports have restarted which has been costly but according to the preliminary results the year seems to be able to reach the budget.

Future development

To consider further expansion of the association is going to be costly, although CIS at this moment has a rather stable economy although that is not a reason for the up and coming years to spend it all. The idea is to have more money in circulation without affecting the members financially. With a larger amount of engaged people there is more possibilities for sponsorships and cooperations.

Conclusion

The CIS board of 22/23 recommends to continue with the current membership fee for at least a couple of years going forward. We do also encourage the next board to look for opportunities to find sponsors and try to provide more for the members without an increased membership fee.
